## 2021 Kawasaki ZX10r Fender Eliminator

- REMOVAL: 1) Remove rear seat (use key) and tool kit.
  - 2) Remove top of tail section (4- allen bolts). \*FIG (A)
  - 3) Pull relays from storage tray. Remove 4- bolts from tray. Lift tray and leave it hanging off side of bike.\*FIG (B)
  - 4) Remove rear fender (4- allen bolts on underside) unplug wires shown in \*FIG (C).
  - 5) Cut wires as shown in FIG (D).

**INSTALL:** 

- 1) Secure your license plate to Main Assembly (2- 6x10 allen bolts in lower holes. Washers and nuts behind).
- 2) Mount Signal brackets (use 2-6x12 allen bolts through upper holes) and mount your turn signals. \*FIG (E)
- 3) Insert Small Grommets in Main Assembly and route signal wires as shown in FIG (E).
- 4) Hold Main Assembly in position to undertail and mark location shown in FIG (F).
- 5) Carefully drill 1/4" hole at location marked in previous step. \*FIG (G)
- 6) Adhere License Light to Main Assembly. Snip wire ends off and strip about a 1/4" of coating from ends.
- 7) Place Large Grommet in square hole of undertail.
- 8) Route license light wire through previously drilled hole and signal wires through large grommet.
- 9) Mount Main Assembly to undertail using stock bolts. \*FIG (H)
- 10) Plug in wires that were cut in step 5 of removal.
- 11) Connect wires. Use Butt Connectors for license light and splice connectors for signals. \*See Color Chart\*
- 12) Check lighting for proper function.
- 13) Replace storage tray and relays.
- 14) Replace top of tail section, tool kit, and seat.
