**NOTE:** We highly recommend using a medium strength thread lock product, such as Blue Loctite<sup>®</sup>, on all of the bolts when installing your Corbin Saddlebags.


- 1. Start by removing your stock seat. See owner's manual if necessary
- 2. Remove the stock fender bolts or sissybar mounting brackets, using a 6mm Allen key (Figure 2).

**NOTE**: Remove one fender bolt at a time.

3. Install a double sided stud and 8mm fender washer where you just removed the stock fender bolt, using a 5/8" open wrench (Figure 3). Tighten studs and use Loctite®.

**NOTE:** The 8mm side of the bolt goes into the fender (smaller side of the bolt).

- 4. Repeat on the other side.
- 5. Mount the saddlebags (*Figure 4*) and secure with the supplied 3/8" flat washer, 3/8" lock washer and 3/8" acorn nuts (*Figure 5*). Snug the bolts into place, but do not tighten yet.






6. Install the bottom mounting bridge bracket using the supplied 8mm Allen bolts and 8mm flat washers (Figure 6), using a 5mm Allen key.

**NOTE:** You may need to manually move bags into position to align the bracket.

7. Next, go back and tighten all the bolts securely.
