

MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Honda Gold Wing GL1800 2006-2017 with OEM heat - One-piece Seat

Hardware: Stock side Allen bolts x 4

Tools needed: Metric Allen wrenches

Note: These instructions are for installing Mustang seats 79902 and 79909 on GL1800 models **with** OEM heat. If your model does not have OEM heat, please refer to the instructions for 79900 and 79907.

Removal of Stock Seat:

- Remove the left side battery cover and disconnect the battery.
- 2. Remove the grab rails from the motorcycle by removing the two Allen bolts.



- 3. Lift the stock seat up and back slightly to disconnect the front tab and unplug the OEM connector from the motorcycle's plug.
- 4. Lift seat up and back to remove it from the motorcycle.

Installation of Mustang Seat:

- 1. Ensure the battery is disconnected.
- 2. Ensure the sub-harness cable is connected to the Mustang seat and the colored wires match.



- 3. Connect the seat's 10-pin connector to the OEM heater connector. It should click into place. Ensure the wires are not pinched or stretched, and route the wiring down the left side of the frame along the rails.
- 4. Holding the back of the seat up against the passenger backrest, slide the nose bracket under the frame's receiver. If the side panels seem to interfere with install, slide the seat back until the nose of the seat drops below the side covers, then push forward.

5. Align the grab rails to the seat, slide the stock Allen bolts through the grab rails and the seat, and into the frame mounting bosses.

6. Tighten the four Allen bolts securely and reconnect the battery.

Enjoy the comfort and custom look of your new Mustang seat!
