

#### **MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:**

## Harley-Davidson<sup>®</sup> FLDE & FLHC 2018

Solo and Passenger Seat

Hardware (Included): Solo: Passenger seat:

Small retaining washer x 2 none

Slotted mounting nuts

**Tools needed:** Flat screwdriver

<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" hex wrench

#### **Removal of Stock Seat:**

- 1. Remove the rear ¼"-20 fender screw with a screwdriver and set it aside. The stock rear fender screw will be used to attach your new Mustang seat.
- 2. Slide the passenger seat back and up to remove from the motorcycle.
- 3. Remove the two nuts which mount the solo to the stud plate.
- 4. Carefully lift the solo up and back to disengage the front bracket and remove the solo.



5. Remove the handstrap from the studs.

### **Installation of Mustang seat:**

#### Solo:

- 1. Remove one of the large retaining washers from the stud plate in the front of the fender and replace with the supplied smaller retaining washer.

  Do not remove both retaining washers at the same time.
- 2. Repeat for the other retaining washer.





- 3. Holding the Mustang solo fairly level to the frame, engage the front bracket into the frame mount behind the tank. Sliding the seat slightly forward and back will ease aligning the bracket and engaging it into the proper location.
- 4. Once front bracket is properly engaged, lower the rear brackets onto the stud plate. Use the supplied slotted nuts to secure the seat to the fender. Tighten securely with a  $\frac{5}{8}$ " hex wrench.

## Passenger seat:

1. Engage the Mustang passenger seat's front brackets with the slots on the nuts mounting the solo.

2. Align the rear bracket with the rear fender mount and secure with the stock screw.
