

ITEM 2 = LICENCE PLATE BRACKET (TB0143) (x1).


ITEM 3 = REFLECTOR(x1) NOT SHOWN.

TOOLS REQUIRED


- Set of metric Allen keys to include 4 & 5mm A/F sizes.
 - T25, T30 and T45 Torx bits sockets & wrench.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- To fit the R&G tail tidy, first remove the pillion seat using the key.
- Remove the two bolts arrowed in picture 1 from under the pillion seat.
- Remove the two bolts arrowed in pictures 2 and 3.
- Remove the four bolts arrowed in picture 4.
- Remove the original licence plate bracket (this is clipped in place).
- Offer the new licence plate bracket into position (feed between the under-tray and the luggage bracket as shown in picture 5.
- Secure using the two button headed bolts as shown in picture 6.
- Refit the two original rearmost bolts through the mounting brackets on the new licence plate bracket and into the original mounts as shown in pictures 7 and 8.
- IMPORTANT: IF FITTING A FULL-SIZE LICENCE PLATE AND PLACING IT FAR DOWN ON THE LICENCE PLATE HANGER, THERE IS A SMALL CHANCE OF THE LICENCE PLATE HITTING THE BACK WHEEL UNDER HEAVY LOAD AND OVER LARGE BUMPS IN THE ROAD. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK FOR THIS POSSIBILITY AND TAKE AVOIDING ACTION. FAILURE TO CHECK THIS COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY.
- Depending on local laws, attach enclosed reflector in an appropriate location.
- Test the license plate illuminator and all lights before riding.



- Clés Torx T25, T30 et T45.



Instructions de montage:

- Enlever le siège passager en utilisant une clé.
- Enlever les 2 boulons fléchés en Photo 1 par le dessous du siège passager. Enlever les 2 boulons fléchés en Photos 2 et 3.
- Enlever les 4 boulons (Photo 4).
- Enlever le support de plaque d'origine (clippé en place).
- Mettre le nouveau support de plaque en position (Passer entre le sous plateau et le support de bagage (Photo 5)).
- Sécuriser en utilisant 2 boulons (Photo 6).
- Remettre les 2 boulons d'origine les plus à l'arrière à travers les supports de fixation sur le nouveau support de plaque et dans les supports d'origine (Photos 7 et 8).
- IMPORTANT: Si vous installez une grosse plaque, il y a un risque que la plaque entre en contact avec la roue arrière en cas de choc sur la route (bosse, grosse charge etc...). Il est de votre responsabilité de vérifier que cela ne puisse pas se produire. Ne pas effectuer ces vérifications peut entrainer des dommages ainsi que des blessures graves pour le pilote.
- Selon la loi locale, monter des réflecteurs aux emplacements appropriés.
- Revérifiez que les clignotants et les feux de plaque fonctionnent bien avant de prendre la route.

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
